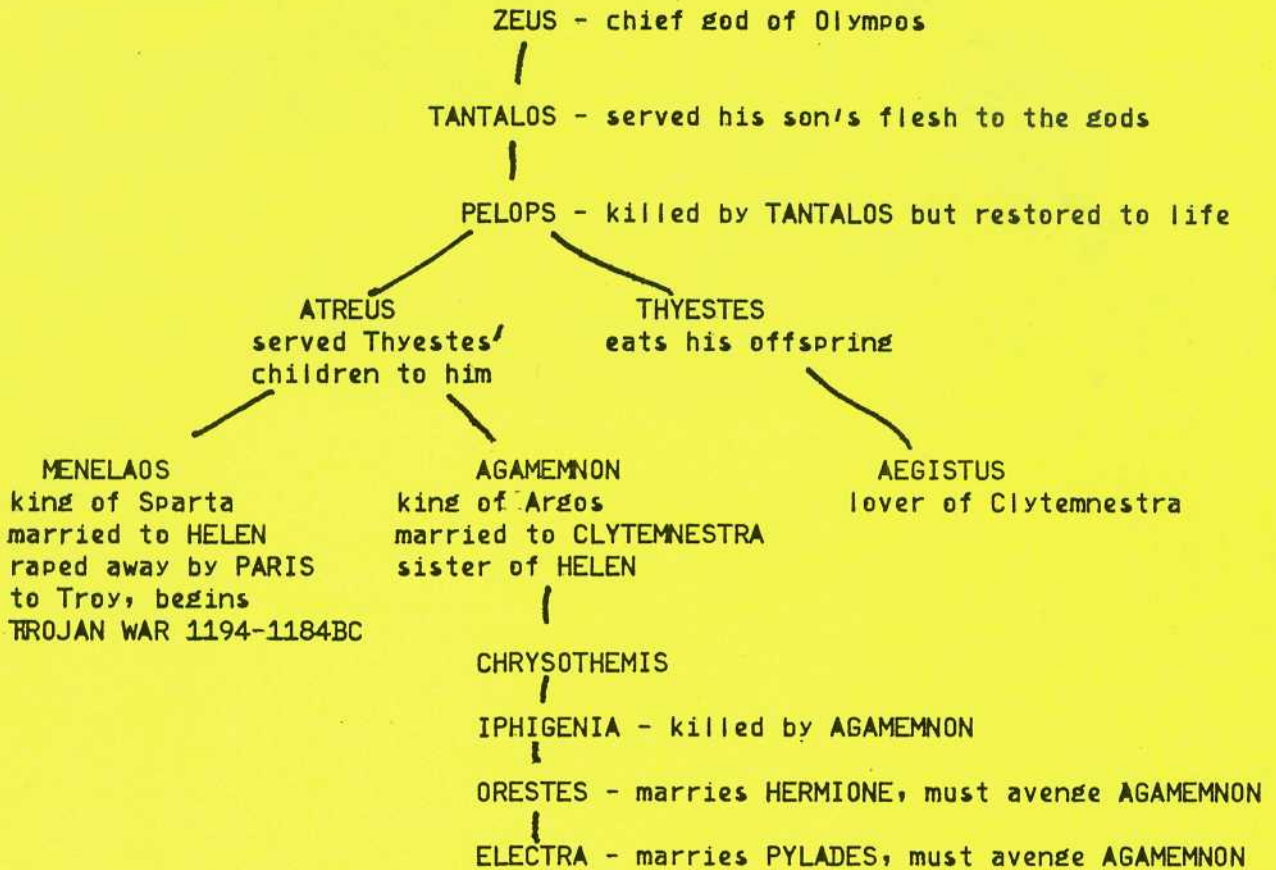


CURSE ON THE HOUSE OF ATREUS
